**'An Act To Include Medical Marijuana Patients in the

Amend the bill in section 1 in §7249-A in the headnote (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "**medicinal**" and inserting the following: '**medical**'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §7249-A in subsection 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "**medicinal**" and inserting the following: '**medical**'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

**'Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.
