### 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §59 is enacted to read:

#### 3 §59. Reducing waste; continued use of forms

A state agency, board, commission or department may not include on any pamphlet,
form or document produced and distributed to the public after January 1, 2014 the name
of an individual office holder, director or other official unless inclusion of the name is
required to effectuate the legal purpose of the document.

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### SUMMARY

9 This bill provides that a state agency, board, commission or department may not 10 include the name of a state agency, board, commission or department official on any 11 document produced and distributed to the public after January 1, 2014 unless the 12 inclusion of the name is required to effectuate the legal purposes of the document. The 13 purpose of this bill is to reduce waste resulting from the need to reprint pamphlets, forms 14 and other documents when the name of a state agency, board, commission or department 15 official changes.
