1 particular, the focus of the stakeholder group will be to explore ways and make  
2 recommendations to address childhood behavioral disorders, attention deficit and  
3 attention deficit hyperactivity disorders, autism spectrum disorders and child obesity  
4 through nutritional strategies that include food choices and dietary supplementation. The  
5 departments are required to present the work of the stakeholder group to the Joint  
6 Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs and the Joint Standing Committee  
7 on Health and Human Services and may suggest legislation to the joint standing  
8 committees, which may each submit legislation to the Second Regular Session of the  
9 125th Legislature.
