An Act To Authorize the State Employee Health Commission's Preferred Provider Program

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §285, sub-§15 is enacted to read:

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3 15. Preferred provider program. The State Employee Health Commission may develop and implement a preferred provider program, health insurance program or any 4 5 other program the purpose of which is to rank into tiers health care providers, including hospitals and health care organizations, to determine preferred hospital or health care 6 provider status for the state employee health insurance program and to steer the state 7 employee health insurance program members to be treated by or to consult with certain 8 9 health care providers, including hospitals and health care organizations, based on cost and 10 quality of health care. If the commission develops such a program, the commission shall develop a tiering methodology that rates or accounts for effectiveness, safety, patient 11 satisfaction and comparative cost. The commission shall adopt rules to implement this 12 subsection. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are major substantive rules as 13 14 defined in chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

SUMMARY

16 This bill authorizes the State Employee Health Commission to develop and implement a preferred provider program, health insurance program or any other program 17 18 the purpose of which is to rank into tiers health care providers, including hospitals and health care organizations, to determine preferred hospital or health care provider status 19 20 for the state employee health insurance program and to steer the state employee health 21 insurance program members to be treated by or to consult with certain health care 22 providers, including hospitals and health care organizations, based on cost and quality of health care. The commission is directed to adopt major substantive rules to develop and 23 24 implement the preferred provider program.
