Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2 and 3 and inserting the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Provides one-time funding for programming to the sex offender registry system required to designate a registrant as a 10-year or lifetime registrant.
