SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 1383, L.D. 1868, Bill, “An Act To Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine”

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part E the following:

'PART F

Sec. F-1. 10 MRSA §9903, sub-§1, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 622, §1, is amended to read:

B. Unemployment insurance; taxes or fees or workers' compensation insurance taxes or fees; and

Sec. F-2. Retroactivity. That section of this Part that amends the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 9903, subsection 1, paragraph B applies retroactively to April 12, 2012.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment corrects a clerical error by removing a comma that was erroneously included in a description of the fees and taxes that are not required to be paid by an out-of-state business that responds to a state of emergency in this State. The law corrected by this amendment was enacted by Public Law 2011, chapter 622.
