14 15	Whereas, Hebron Academy is a college preparatory boarding and day school located in the Town of Hebron; and
16 17	Whereas, Hebron Academy's student body currently represents many different countries and many states throughout the United States; and
18 19 20 21	Whereas, it is important to ensure that directional signs be in place immediately because increased visibility on the Interstate 95 corridor is critical to the ability of the public, as well as those members of the student body who are unfamiliar with the State, to locate Hebron Academy; and
22 23 24 25	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it'
