4 5 6 7	9. Possession of hunting equipment on Sunday. Possession Except as provided under section 11205, subsection 1-A, possession of hunting equipment in the fields or forests or on the waters or ice in the State on Sunday is prima facie evidence of a violation of section 11205, unless:
8	A. The hunting equipment is carried, securely wrapped, in a complete cover;
9	B. The hunting equipment is fastened in a case; or
10 11 12 13 14	C. The hunting equipment is carried in at least 2 separate pieces in such a manner that it can not be fired, unless the separate pieces are joined together. For the purpose of this subsection, a clip, magazine or cylinder of a firearm may not be considered a piece of the hunting equipment. Bows and arrows must be kept in a case or cover if broadheads or field points are kept attached to the arrows.
