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SUMMARY

2 This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. The amendment is consistent with the intent of the bill and makes 3 changes to clarify that the school administrative unit may be represented by counsel at an 4 5 individualized education program team meeting concerning a child with a disability only when the parents are represented by an attorney at the individualized education program 6 7 team meeting. The amendment also provides that the attorney representing the parent 8 must provide 7 days' written notice, which both parties may waive, to the superintendent of the school administrative unit that the attorney will be representing the parent at the 9 10 individualized education program team meeting.
