The failure of a municipality in a district with 10 or more municipalities to hold a biennial caucus does not prohibit voters in that municipality from participating in and voting at a meeting to nominate or elect a person to fill a vacancy under section 381 or 382.'

It provides that when a political committee holds a meeting to fill a vacancy for a candidacy or seat for a State Senator or Representative in a legislative district containing 10 or more municipalities, the political committee must permit anyone enrolled in the party to vote to nominate or elect a person to fill the vacancy. It also provides that the failure of a municipality in that district to hold a biennial municipal caucus does not prohibit voters in that municipality from participating in or voting at the meeting to fill a vacancy.
