1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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2 Sec. 1. School fund allowed to lapse to general fund. Notwithstanding the 3 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 13, chapter 93, subchapter 5, the Town of Burlington is 4 authorized to allow the funds that are in the town's school and ministerial fund to lapse to 5 the town's general fund.

SUMMARY

7 This bill authorizes the Town of Burlington to allow the funds remaining in the 8 town's school and ministerial fund to lapse to the town's general fund.
