Department of Environmental Protection to amend rules. 2 Resolved: That the Department of Environmental Protection shall amend its rules 3 governing the protection of natural resources, site location of development and storm 4 water to provide that permits issued with respect to these areas are valid for 5 years after 5 they are issued and that a person who holds such a permit has 10 years to complete a 6 project pursuant to such a permit.

## SUMMARY

8 This resolve directs the Department of Environmental Protection to amend its rules 9 governing the protection of natural resources, site location of development and storm 10 water to provide that permits issued with respect to these areas are valid for 5 years after 11 they are issued and that a person who holds such a permit has 10 years to complete a 12 project pursuant to such a permit.

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
