2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §6203, sub-§4 is enacted to read:
3	4. Funds for deer wintering areas. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
4	contrary, 25% of all proceeds in the Land for Maine's Future Fund must be used for the
5	purchase and maintenance of deer wintering areas, as identified by the Department of
6	Inland Fisheries and Wildlife pursuant to Title 12, section 10107.
7	SUMMARY
8 9	This bill requires 25% of the Land for Maine's Future Fund to be used for the purchase and maintenance of wintering areas for deer.
