- 1. Do the prevailing wage rate requirements apply to this project?
 - 1.1. The deep cleaning project is considered maintenance work. As a result, the prevailing wage rates that apply to State-funded construction projects costing \$50,000 or more do not apply.
- 2. Related to the cleaning of the ceiling tiles, are we expected to remove stains or dust and vacuum?
 - 2.1. The cleaning of the ceiling tiles is limited to dusting and vacuuming, as well as cleaning of the gridwork face.
- 3. Is cleaning of carpeting included?
 - 3.1. Yes. As stated in the RFP, all carpeting is to be steam cleaned.
- 4. Is cleaning of fixtures included?
 - 4.1. Yes. As stated in the RFP, the cleaning of light fixtures is included in the project.
- 5. Is the cleaning of frames surrounding hanging art included?
 - 5.1. No.
- 6. Do you want art work to be dusted?
 - 6.1. No.
- 7. In Room 432, does the floor in the kitchenette need to be stripped and waxed?
 - 7.1. No.
- 8. Do chairs need to be steam cleaned?
 - 8.1. No. Only non-fabric chair surfaces are to be cleaned.
- 9. In the House Chamber gallery, are carpets and handrails included?
 - 9.1. Carpets are included in the project, but not the handrails.
- 10. In the House Chamber, are windows included?
 - 10.1. Windows will be cleaned as part of a separate project and are not included in the deep cleaning project. The cleaning of the window shades and blinds is included in this project.
- 11. Is there any particular way you want the window shades to be cleaned?
 - 11.1. The shades are to be vacuumed.
- 12. Are the House Chamber skylights included?
 - 12.1. Only the top side of the skylights are to be cleaned.
- 13. Do you want us to move couches when cleaning floors?
 - 13.1. Yes.

- 14. Can file cabinets be moved for us?
 - 14.1. Full-sized file cabinets will remain in place. Cleaning can be done around the file cabinets.
- 15. Are partitions included?
 - 15.1. Yes. Partitions/cubicle walls are included.
- 16. Is the glass in interior doors included? 16.1. Yes.
- 17. In Room 333 and other similar rooms, is the top half-moon shade able to be removed or is it fixed? 17.1. The shades are able to be removed.
- 18. Are bathrooms included in the spaces that include bathrooms? 18.1. Yes. Both bathroom and kitchen areas are included.
- 19. In the House Chamber, is the glass behind the legislator seats in the Chamber included? 19.1. Yes.
- 20. In the House Chamber, we cleaning the desk surfaces but not the interior of the desk drawers, correct?
 - 20.1. Correct.
- 21. Is the ornate trim in the House Chamber included?
 - 21.1. Yes, the ornate trim is included, but not the voting displays.
