This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward in the Joint Enforcement Agreement-NOAA account for the purpose of purchasing one Rigid Hull Inflatable. The Bureau maintains a fleet of patrol vessels greater than 40 feet in length that support law enforcement and search and rescue missions. Each patrol vessel is outfitted with a 16-foot rigid hull inflatable boat used to conduct vessel boardings, law enforcement operations, and search and rescue activities. Failure to allot these funds would impact the capacity to respond to emergency search and rescue situations.

For these reasons, a generator is necessary to maintain operations and prevent facility damage. Funding is no longer required in Professional Services and the All Other line category will have sufficient resources to meet obligations for the remainder of the fiscal year. Failure to allot these funds would impact the department's operational responsibilities in the event of a power outage.

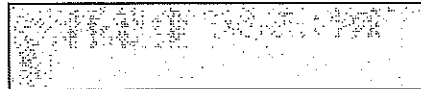



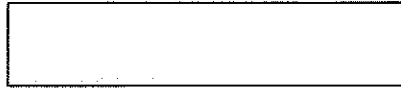
