This laboratory equipment is being purchased for emergency preparedness reasons. If the current equipment breaks and cannot be repaired, the laboratory cannot simply cease operations since the cessation of testing puts patient care in jeopardy and staging equipment such as this increases the likelihood of maintaining continuity of operations. Funds are no longer required in the All Other line category for the purpose for which they were originally intended due to a reduction in supplies expenditures. Funding is provided by the Epidemiology and Laboratory for Infectious Diseases (ELC) grant.



Statement of Fact

This financial order provides allotment to purchase two Hepatitis C RNA point of care (POC) GeneXpert Xpress devices for the Maine Health and Environmental Testing Laboratory (HETL). The POC devices provide rapid, accurate testing of Hepatitis C which will help the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) protect public health from the spread of blood-borne diseases. While (POC) Hepatitis C antibody testing is now widely available, no POC device option was available for confirmation testing to determine whether an individual had an active Hepatitis C infection requiring treatment, until recently. The devices will allow for onsite confirmatory testing and reduce barriers for linkage to treatment services. Funds are no longer required in the All Other line category for the purpose for which they were originally intended due to a reduction in contractual obligations. Funding is provided by the Integrated Viral Hepatitis Surveillance and Prevention Funding for Health Departments grant award.






