Public Law 2023, chapter 643, Part D allocated funding to support positions necessary to complete projects initially funded with funds received through the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. This position began on January 12, 2025 and ends on October 31, 2026. The position was originally established in account 025-05A-Z081-94, Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER). As the ESSER grants closes, the position will shift the work effort to provide subrecipient monitoring support to alternate grant funding received through the American Rescue Plan Act. Failure to allot these funds will limit the department's ability to effectively monitor federal emergency relief funding.

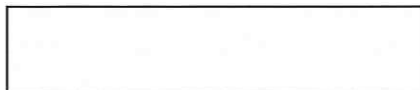

Public Law 2023, chapter 643, Part D allocates funding to support positions necessary to complete projects initially funded through the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and authorizes the extension of limited-period positions beyond 2 years.
