Funds are no longer required in the All Other line category for the purpose for which they were originally intended due to a reduction in projected contractual obligations. Funding is provided by the Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Infectious Disease (ELC) grant award.

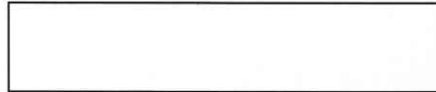
