



More inspections are being completed in FY17 than originally anticipated. The current allocation level for this account in FY17 is insufficient to absorb this change. Failure to allot these funds will stall the inspections and put at risk the state's compliance with the provisions cited in the Food Drug and Cosmetic Act (FD&C Act) as amended by the Tobacco Control Act, Section C.
