PROCEDURAL ORDER

The Kennebec County Superior Court has filed a report pursuant to M.R. App. P. 24(a). The Court understands that time is of the essence. It is therefore ORDERED as follows:

1. The parties shall each file, at or before **noon on Thursday April 12**, 2018, a position paper, not to exceed ten pages, on the substance of the reported questions and any known time constraints regarding the Court's final action. The position papers must be filed electronically by emailing а native pdf of the papers to lawcourt.clerk@courts.maine.gov, and by filing a paper copy on or before 2:00 p.m. on April 12, 2018.

2. The Court will hear from the parties at **2:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 12, 2018,** in Courtroom 12 (the Supreme Judicial Court courtroom) of the Cumberland County Courthouse in Portland. The time allotted to each party and the order of the parties' presentations will be announced by the Clerk of the Law Court prior to the commencement of the proceeding.
