What the Budget purchases:

The Telecommunications Relay Services Council Fund was established as a nonlapsing fund to fund the activities of the council in accordance with 35 MRSA §2-A. The fund receives funds transferred by the commission in accordance with section 7104, subsection 7. No more than \$600,000 may be transferred into the fund annually.

The Council is tasked with administering the Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) program within the State. TRS is a program where individuals call a single number, 7-1-1, which connects them to the TRS Provider for the State who acts as a translator between hearing individuals and Deaf or Hard of Hearing individuals call a single number, 7-1-1, which among all users of the public switched telephone network. The primary benefit of this system is that it does not require both parties to the call to have assistive devices, such as TTY machines.
