BILL ANALYSIS

LD 203 - An Act To Increase Funding for the St. Croix International Waterway Commission (Moore)

Bill summary and legislative history

This bill provides an additional \$25,000 per fiscal year to the St. Croix International Waterway Commission (the "Commission") but only if the Province of New Brunswick, Canada commits to match the funding.

As noted by the sponsor, LD 203 is essentially identical to LD 450, a bill worked and voted unanimously by the ENR Committee during the 129th Legislature. That bill was reported out of ENR in 2019 but remained on the Special Appropriations Table through the adjournment sine die of the Second Regular Session of the 129th Legislature and thus died upon the termination of that Legislature.

Issues, suggested amendments and other notes

1. Biennial budget initiative – as noted by the sponsor, the same funding increase for the Commission is included as an initiative in the Governor's proposed biennial budget (see attached), which the AFA Committee has recently begun its work on. The Commission is one of the entities under ENR's budgetary subject matter jurisdiction and the proposed initiative is included as part of the budget portions that will be heard by ENR and AFA during a joint hearing on March 5.

From comments made by the sponsor, it appears that this bill is intended to serve as a backup proposal in the event that the Commission's budget initiative does not make it into the final budget amendment.

Fiscal impact
