

- Based on the SoS information
- This is the email address that will be exposed to the general public via all avenues: web links, register, etc..
- Nicknames are okay within reason
- May grant your aide access
- Reach out to your caucus office Chief of Staff (or the Clerk or Secretary if you do not have a caucus office.

What we'll use your email for:

- Email is the primary method of communication for the Legislature
 - Daily Calendars
 - Public hearings and work sessions on your bills
 - Committee schedules
 - Rule making notices
 - HR, Benefits information
 - Emergency closures and postponements
 - General announcements
 - Communications with staff

Why it's important to use your Legislative Account


- IT'S ARCHIVED! When email is sent to or from your Legislative email account, it passes through our email system here where it is archived before being sent on it's way either to your inbox or on to the outside
- Should you be the target of a FOAA request, the archives can be searched to provide a response to the requestor
- If you use a personal account to conduct legislative business and that account shows up on a FOAA request, you can be asked to provide all correspondence from that account as well -- Google will be of no help

Legislative Email Organization


