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SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and changes the title. The amendment establishes a per diem amount to be paid to the Maine Veterans' Homes facilities for each MaineCare member, in addition to the regular reimbursement for a MaineCare member in a nursing facility or residential care facility. The per diem must be adjusted for inflation to the same

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extent that nursing facilities and residential care facilities are adjusted. Upon 1 implementation of the rate calculation process established by this legislation, any 2 supplemental payments appropriated for the Maine Veterans' Homes in Public Law 2023, 3 chapter 412 that have not been expended may no longer be provided in supplemental 4 payments but may be used for the purposes of this legislation. The amendment also adds 5 6 an appropriations and allocations section.
