COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 134, L.D. 456, Bill, “An Act To Strengthen the Qualifications for County Sheriffs”

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §371-B, sub-§3, ¶E, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 342, §34, is amended to read:

E. The candidate swears to or affirms that the candidate has at least ~~5~~ 2 years of supervisory employment experience in law enforcement or corrections or a combination of both and submits the name, address and telephone number for the relevant employer or employers.'

SUMMARY

This amendment reduces the required number of years of supervisory experience from 5 years to 2 years and specifies that the supervisory experience must be in law enforcement or corrections or a combination of both.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT
