Recommendations on LR 1045, Supplemental Budget

Pursuant to Joint Rule 314, our committee has reviewed the portions of LR 1045 relating to the committee's subject matter jurisdiction and has <u>voted to support all the provisions</u> as presented with the exception of Section A-8, Ref. # 114 (ACF 3) and Part J-1.

The committee voted unanimously to support a <u>correction of program name and code</u> in Section A-8, Ref. # 114. The amended version (attached item #1) strikes out the current program name and code and replaces it with the correct program name and code. This proposed change does not alter the total of the supplemental budget changes proposed by the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry.

The committee voted 11-2 to support an amendment that would amend the language in section J-1, which currently redirects revenue to a dedicated account to allow for payment of leases for state park land. Revenues not used to pay leases would be deposited in the General Fund under the current language, excepting certain fees paid for the Allagash Wilderness Waterway. After discussion, the committee concluded that the broad language in the current Section J-1 might obligate the Legislature to pay for future leases held by the Department without the opportunity to know any specifics about those leases, particularly the amount of revenue needed to fund them. The majority committee vote proposes that the Appropriations Committee strike and replace section J-1 (see attached item #2) so that the amendment to 12 MRSA §1819, second ¶ only obligates payment of the lease for Crescent Beach State Park from state park user fees prior to the balance of those fees accruing to the General Fund. This proposed change does not alter the proposed total of supplemental budget changes proposed by the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry.

The minority report on J-1 was a vote recommending against section J-1 being included in the supplemental budget, either in its original or amended form.

The Committee also requested that the Department report back to the Committee later in the session on the status of the Crescent Beach State Park lease issue.
