

Recommendations on L.D. 45, the Supplemental Budget Bill for FY 2009

Pursuant to Joint Rule 314, our committee has reviewed the portions of supplemental budget bill relating to the committee's subject matter jurisdiction and has voted on all items. Our votes are indicated on the worksheets provided by the Office of Fiscal and Program Review and attached to this memo. A simple check mark in the Committee Vote line indicates unanimous acceptance on an item. The word "OUT" means a unanimous recommendation to remove this item from LD 45. Divided reports are recorded with numbers.

We want to emphasize our recommendation to retain the Forester I and two Forest Technician positions within the Bureau of Parks and Lands (BPL). These positions are fully funded from a dedicated account. This account is self sustaining with income from timber harvesting on the public lands. Without these positions, BPL's capacity to develop harvest plans, lay out harvest areas and supervise the harvest is significantly reduced. The end result is less wood harvested and reduced income to the fund. The income associated with these positions exceeds their cost and this cost is NOT to the General Fund. The income from the trust lands is used to support improved public access and multiple use recreation opportunities on the public lands. As expressed by members of AFA at three joint public hearing and work session, we are bewildered as to why these positions were frozen and now being eliminated.

The ACF committee accepts all of the items in LD 45 pertaining to the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources except for one that we would have tabled. This is item Ref. # 156-P14 on page 7 of the worksheet. This reduces an allocation to the Maine Milk Commission. We ask that you refrain from action on this item until Tuesday afternoon, on January 21st.


