We understand that Part B has already been moved in by your committee, so we have not me to take a vote on this piece. However, we wanted to be sure and note Rep. Damon's objection.

Finally, we have only just received the change package this morning regarding the Gambling Control Board and the fees to cover the costs of considering the application for the casino in Oxford County. The committee has significant concerns with regard to this item and will attend your worksession today to raise them and pose questions of those in attendance.
