Correctional/Judicial Impact: This legislation expands the scope of prohibited conduct and aggravating factors of an offense as it

relates to a Class D crime, elevating it to a Class C crime if the actor has prior convictions. This will increase the average length of stay by 1 year and 4 months (486 days) and must be served in a state correctional facility. The average increased cost to the state for each occurrence is \$50,165. The Judicial Department indicates that increasing minimum sentences by "assigning special weight" could require additional judicial resources for processing these cases. However, this bill could also prevent escalating violence and result in a reduction of trial days and needed resources. The net effect should

be minimal on the Judicial Department.

Correctional/Judicial Impact: This legislation allows blended sentencing for certain juveniles convicted as adults and sentenced to

imprisonment if the juvenile has not attained 16 years of age at the time of sentencing. Prior to age 18 the time will be served in a juvenile facility. Once the juvenile reaches 18 the remaining time will be served at an adult correctional facility. A juvenile facility costs \$343.37 per day more than an adult facility, or \$125,330 more per year. This type of sentence occurs once every two years which implies an annualized cost of \$62,665 to the system if, on average, an offender turns 17 at the time the

sentence begins.
