PASTOR HATCH: Before I begin this morning, I just want to make a couple remarks. First of all, please don't invite me again in February. The last two or three times I've been asked to pray before the Senate in February, we have always been involved in a major snow storm. Perhaps it might be wise not to invite me. I'm not superstitious, but you might be. I want to tell you a brief story this morning. My wife and I decided we would take a canoe up the Sheepscot River on the upper part of Sheepscot Lake in Palermo. We went up and the river was fairly high. It was spring time and it was much higher than when we'd ever gone before. My stepfather had died, and as part of his estate I received some fishing tackle and I had decided to try to ut. We went up further than we had ever gone, and as we were coming back down, the river was going fairly slow. All of a sudden there was a place where it came together in a short way and it sped up. My wife and I don't know who was responsible, probably both of us, but we over-reacted and the canoe turned over and went into the water. We were both near freezing. I wasn't sure what to do, so I said, 'I'd better get out of the water.' I did and I told my wife, 'hang onto the canoe.' We got the canoe out of the water and then I thought I ought to save her too. That took place and after that we went and got the fishing tackle that was at the bottom of the stream on a very cold day. I guess the point that I want to make on this is that during a crisis it's often very easy for us to over-react. As people, we so often find ourselves in situations where we have problems that are facing us and we over correct. Many times we can tip the canoe. For Christians, which I am, our faith is founded in the word of God; the bible. We find in its' teachings something that gives us a keel that goes deep under the water, that helps stabilize us during difficult times. Someone once said, and I think it's a good statement: 'never doubt in the dark what you learned in the light.' I would like to encou
